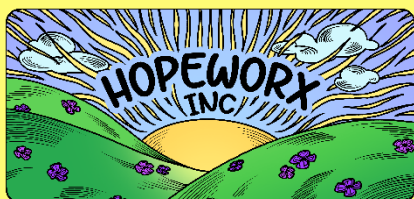
## Adult Peer Advocacy Program
